**ADVANCED OPEN WATER COURSE**

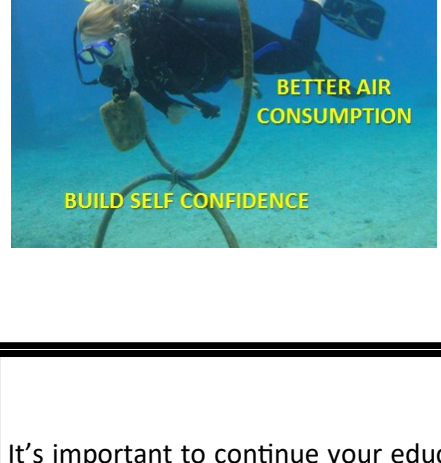
The Advanced Open Water Diver Course (AOW) is the next step in learning advanced skills directly applicable to scuba diving. Frequently, an AOW card is just the ticket to diving at a variety of more sites. For example, we know of several places in the Philippines, Malaysia, Australia, and some wreck sites in Florida who will not let you dive at certain, more advanced sites, unless you have the AOW or above certification. The reason is that the operators don't want to risk putting OW divers into certain advanced level dive conditions such as currents or deep, blue water, environments. They know that PADI AOW certified divers have the skills and experience necessary for such sites.



There are a total of 5 dives necessary to complete the course. The required 2 Core dives are Deep and Underwater Navigation. You can choose the remaining 3 Adventure Dives. This course is for newly certified divers as well as divers with more experience who wish to expand their knowledge and practical skills. Also, if you don't have enough time to complete the full AOW course, the Adventure Diver rating is awarded after completion after any 3 Adventure Dives.

**Why should you take the Advanced Open Water Course?**

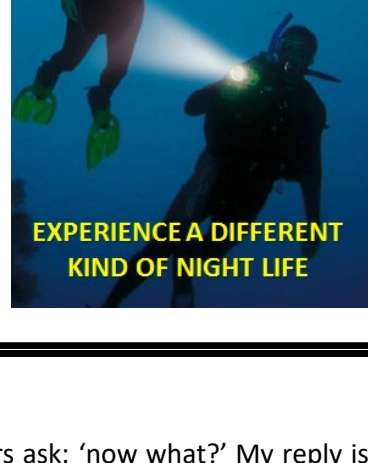
Open Water Divers have learned the basics, the "how" of diving. After a few dives, there is a need to expand that dive knowledge and learn practical skills which can increase your enjoyment of diving. Ever surface far away from the boat and have a long surface swim back? With the Navigation dive, you will learn how to prevent that situation, using compass as well as natural navigational aids to assist in your underwater journey. For deep diving, there are special concerns, and as an Open Water Diver, you are certified to dive 18 meters/60 feet. After completing the AOW course, that level is extended to 30 meters/100 feet.

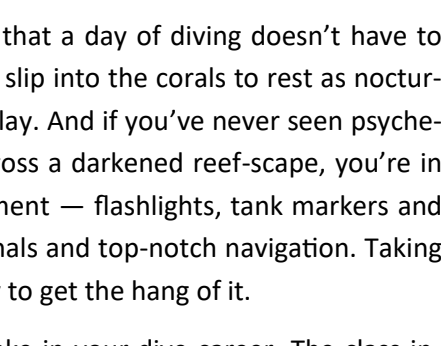

**IT'S TIME TO SPECIALIZE**

It's important to continue your education as a diver for several reasons. Many newly certified divers ask: 'now what?' My reply is that every course you take expands your skill set and your experience, opening doors to new diving opportunities. It's a great way to connect with other divers. For all these reasons and more, we at Amber Waves Diving offer a vast lineup of continuing-education courses that provide experience and training for just about any diving activity you can imagine. Here are just a few that you should consider.

**Core Specialty - Search and Recovery**

In the PADI Search and Recovery Diver specialty course, you will learn how to effectively search for and raise objects weighing 10 to 100 pounds. You will learn what equipment is needed for an effective search and the importance of proper search planning. During your training, you will do four open water dives.



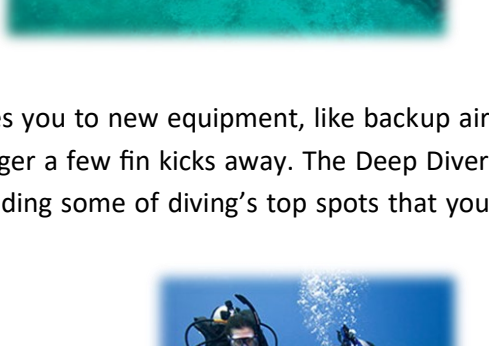
**Core Specialty - Night Diver**

No amount of day diving can prepare you for the thrill and challenge of descending onto a reef under the cover of darkness. You learn that the dark isn't scary and that a day of diving doesn't have to end when the sun goes down. After dark, the usual fish slip into the corals to rest as nocturnal predators like octopuses and lobsters come out to play. And if you've never seen psychedelic displays of bioluminescent plankton exploding across a darkened reef-escape, you're in for a treat. But diving in the dark requires extra equipment — flashlights, tank markers and entry/exit lights — not to mention specialized hand signals and top-notch navigation. Taking the plunge with an experienced instructor is a great way to get the hang of it.

A Night Diver specialty course is one of the best continuing- education decisions you can make in your dive career. The class includes three night dives, during which you'll learn everything from how to communicate with other divers using your flashlight underwater to safe entry and exit techniques, and how to navigate in the dark.

**Core Specialty - Deep Diver**

Diving the deeper half of the recreational diving limits — from 60 to 130 feet — can seem both seductive and daunting to a new diver. On a reef wall or underwater lake cliff, it's easy to slip into the inky-blue depths without even noticing, and many of the best shipwreck dives lie in deep, open waters.



As we drop below 60 feet, our air consumption goes up, our no-stop time goes down, our buoyancy declines, and we begin to feel the effects of nitrogen narcosis. None of these are hard to deal with, but you have to know how to manage them.

The PADI Deep Diver course is the best way to log some deep dives under the watchful eye of an instructor. Not only does the class include four deep dives, but it also introduces you to new equipment, like backup air tanks, and teaches you how to plan for and manage problems when the surface is no longer a few fin kicks away. The Deep Diver course opens the door to wrecks, walls and other sites in the 60- to 130-foot range, including some of diving's top spots that you might otherwise miss.

**Core Specialty - Peak Performance Buoyancy**

Excellent buoyancy control is what defines skilled scuba divers. You've seen them underwater. They glide effortlessly, use less air and ascend, descend or hover almost as if by thought. They more easily observe aquatic life without disturbing their surroundings. You can achieve this, too.
